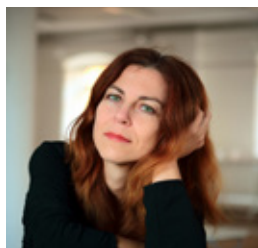

# WHAT TO SUBMIT?

## LILA 2018 FOR **OFFICES**

The jury will be looking for **offices** practicing landscape architecture that demonstrate experiment and advanced approaches to design process. Offices need to submit office profiles following simple instructions. Office must be at least 2 years old and have at least one project built. Existing entries from LILA 2016 and 2017 will automatically be considered, no further action is required. Download zipped folder structure to begin with your submission.

### MATERIAL:

1. **basic data:** name, www, contact ...
2. **main photo:** photo of members or studio environment (min width 2500px, landscape format)
3. Office **philosophy text**, up to 3500 characters
4. 3-5 of your best projects  
– **9 images** per each project (min width 2500px)  
– description text (max 1500 characters) in english
5. optional: link to **videos** on YouTube or video

## LILA 2018 FOR **PUBLIC LANDSCAPE PROJECTS**

The jury will also be looking for built, publicly accessible landscape architecture **projects**, built in 2014 or later. Offices can submit any number of their best works. Existing eligible entries from LILA 2016 and 2017 will automatically be considered, no further action is required. One office can submit any number of entries in the public landscape project category. Download zipped folder structure to begin with your submission.

### MATERIAL:

1. **basic data:** project name, location, year ...
2. **main project photo**
3. **narrative**, 500 – 5000 characters with spaces (problems, solutions and why you think the project should be awarded)
4. **9-30 images** (photos+other graphics)
5. optional: link to **videos** on YouTube or Vimeo

## LILA 2018 FOR **PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL GARDENS**

The jury will be looking for strictly **private residential gardens** from backyards to estates that were built in 2012 or later. Offices can submit any number of entries. Publicly accessible residential parks (housing) and short-term rentals, such as resorts, hotels, bars and other hospitality premisses will NOT be judged by the jury. One office can submit any number of entries in the garden category. Download zipped folder structure to begin with your submission from LILA registration email.

### MATERIAL:

1. **basic data:** garden name, location, year ...
2. **main project photo**
3. **narrative**, 500 – 5000 characters with spaces (problems, solutions and why you think the project should be awarded)
4. **9-30 images** (photos+other graphics)
5. optional: link to **videos** on YouTube or Vimeo

## GENERAL

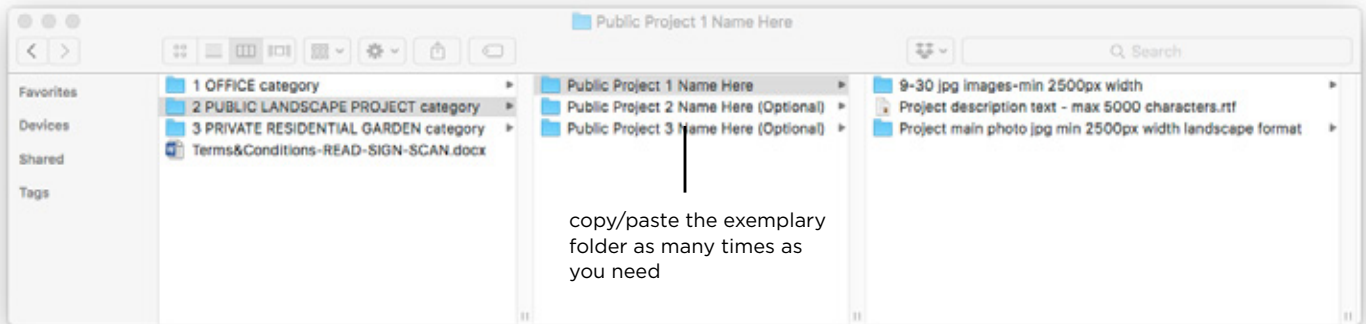
All **texts** must be in english.

All **images** must be in jpg/jpeg format and at least 2500px of width. Do not send .tiff files.

You can include **videos**, but only if they are already hosted on YouTube or Vimeo. Simply copy URL link to the video and paste it in the Basic data text file included in the submission folders.

# HOW TO SUBMIT?

## 1. DOWNLOAD AND FILL THE FOLDERS



Download the folder structure from LILA website or registration instructions email. After you fill the folders, don't forget to read Terms&Conditions. If you agree, simply sign, and paste the scan back to the folder.

## 2. ZIP AND SUBMIT

after you've filled the folders and attached scanned Terms&Conditions, compress the top folder to .zip or .rar and send it back to us via wetransfer.com or similar service to [lila@landezine.com](mailto:lila@landezine.com).

## 3. CALCULATE THE FEE

depending on the number of entries, you need to pay the corresponding fee. The fee for the first entry is 150 euros and 100 euros for each following fee:

*1 entry = 150 euros  
2 entries = 250 euros  
3 entries = 350 euros  
... and so on ...*

example:

*office profile + 2 public projects + 3 gardens = 6 entries*
