Networked design epistemology research
This project introduces a transdisciplinary approach to knowledge generation in the Anthropocene, based on pragmatist theories, mode 2 and mode 3 (transformative) science, and criticality as a means of reflecting on the dynamic interplay of societal forces, professional activities, education, and research. The aim is to evolve epistemological norms and inherited academic and professional practices towards new forms of knowledge production.

Networked design studio research
This project introduces a global and transdisciplinary perspective into learning processes understood as research; it is based on networked studio teaching across one urbanism and one landscape programme and across the Northern and Southern hemispheres (University of Buenos Aires, SLU Malmö). The aim is to develop a body of case studies and, consequently, methodologies for the upgrading of urbanising water landscapes in the Anthropocene, which are exposed to the effects of climate change (changing water regimes) and globalisation (changing social and economic conditions)
- Since 2009 Travelling Transect: working with fragilities
Fieldwork-based design methodologies research
This project introduces a contemporary reinterpretation of Alexander von Humboldt's trans-areal and mobile empirical science into the field of design research: it aims at developing a method for capturing site qualities through deep fieldwork-based empirical enquiry, in-studio elaboration, and communication to off-site audiences, as a basis for a sustainable development of landscapes in the Anthropocene, especially if related to urban water systems.

Case-study based design theory research
This project studies contemporary design approaches for post-industrial landscapes; it aims to update ideas of site-specific design, intuitively associated with recognising static site qualities, and introduces radicant design as a concept that brings transient aspects of site back to mind, such as human uses and processes of nature. Such reconceptualisation of design builds on the exploration of design practices and promotes design research as particularly apt to counter contemporary challenges in the age of the Anthropocene.
